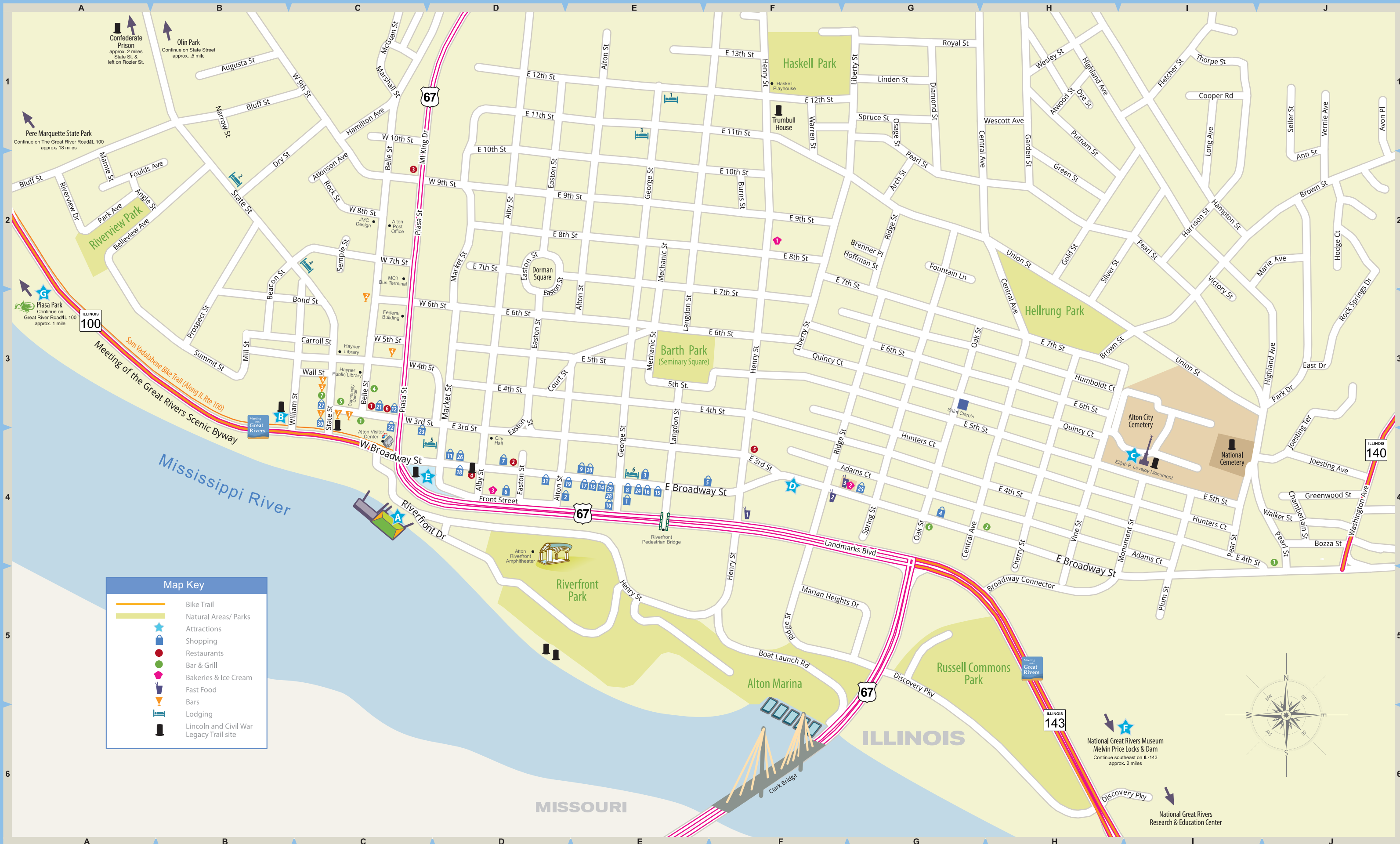

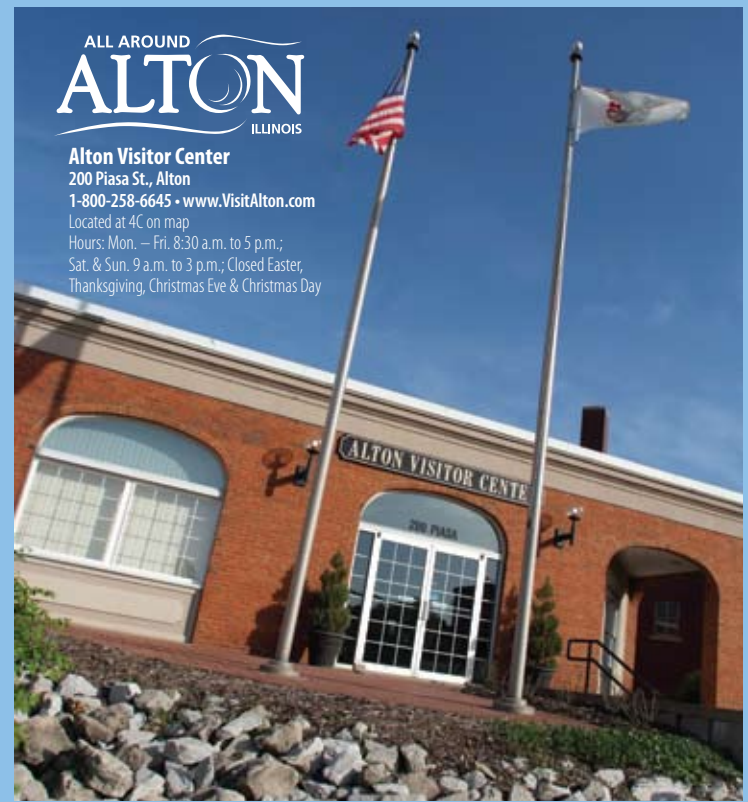

Ride, walk or glide along the streets of Downtown Alton. Bring your bike and hit the trails. The regional bike trails converge on Alton's riverfront with the Alton Bike Trail providing a connection between the MCT Confluence Trail and the Sam Vadalabene Bike Trail. Which begins at Plaza Park and ends at Pere Marquette. Didn't bring your bike? That's fine, too. Spend some time meandering along the riverfront and fountain of Riverfront Park. From the park, venture across the pedestrian bridge into downtown to enjoy the restaurants, shops and historic neighborhoods waiting on the other side. For an experience like no other, plan in advance to park the car and see the sites gliding along on a guided Segway Tour.

### HISTORIC HOMES

Alton is a historic Mississippi River city steeped in history and rich in Victorian and earlier architecture. The city is home to three historic districts listed on the National Register of Historic Places — Christian Hill, Middletown and Upper Alton. Take the time to drive the streets of Alton to view many of the beautiful homes and buildings. Let the **Historic Alton Driving Tour Guide** lead you on your tour through the city, available at the Alton Visitor Center in Downtown Alton.



### STEP BACK IN TIME

Walk in the footsteps of Abraham and Mary Todd Lincoln, and Civil War soldiers from both North and South, as you experience the 10 historic sites on **Alton's Lincoln & Civil War Legacy Trail**. Begin your journey with Lincoln at the famous Lincoln-Douglas Square where the last of the great debates took place. Experience the life of young Lincoln as a lawyer, duelist and orator. See the ruins of the Alton Prison, where more than 1,300 Confederate soldiers perished, and honor their memory at the Confederate Monument & Cemetery. *Trail guides are available at the Alton Visitor Center in Downtown Alton.*
